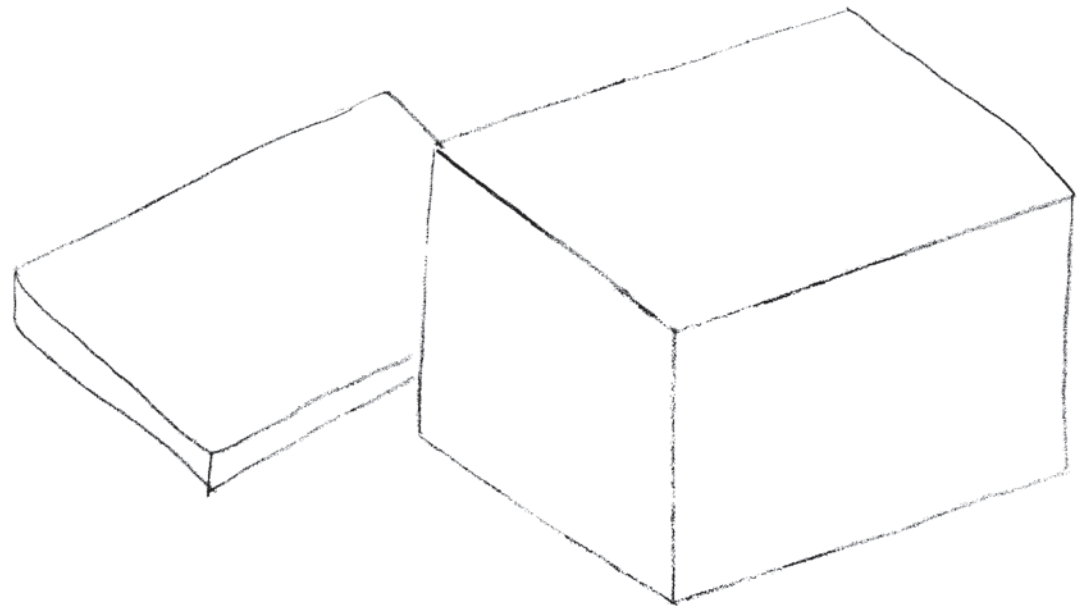


Your Box of Memories

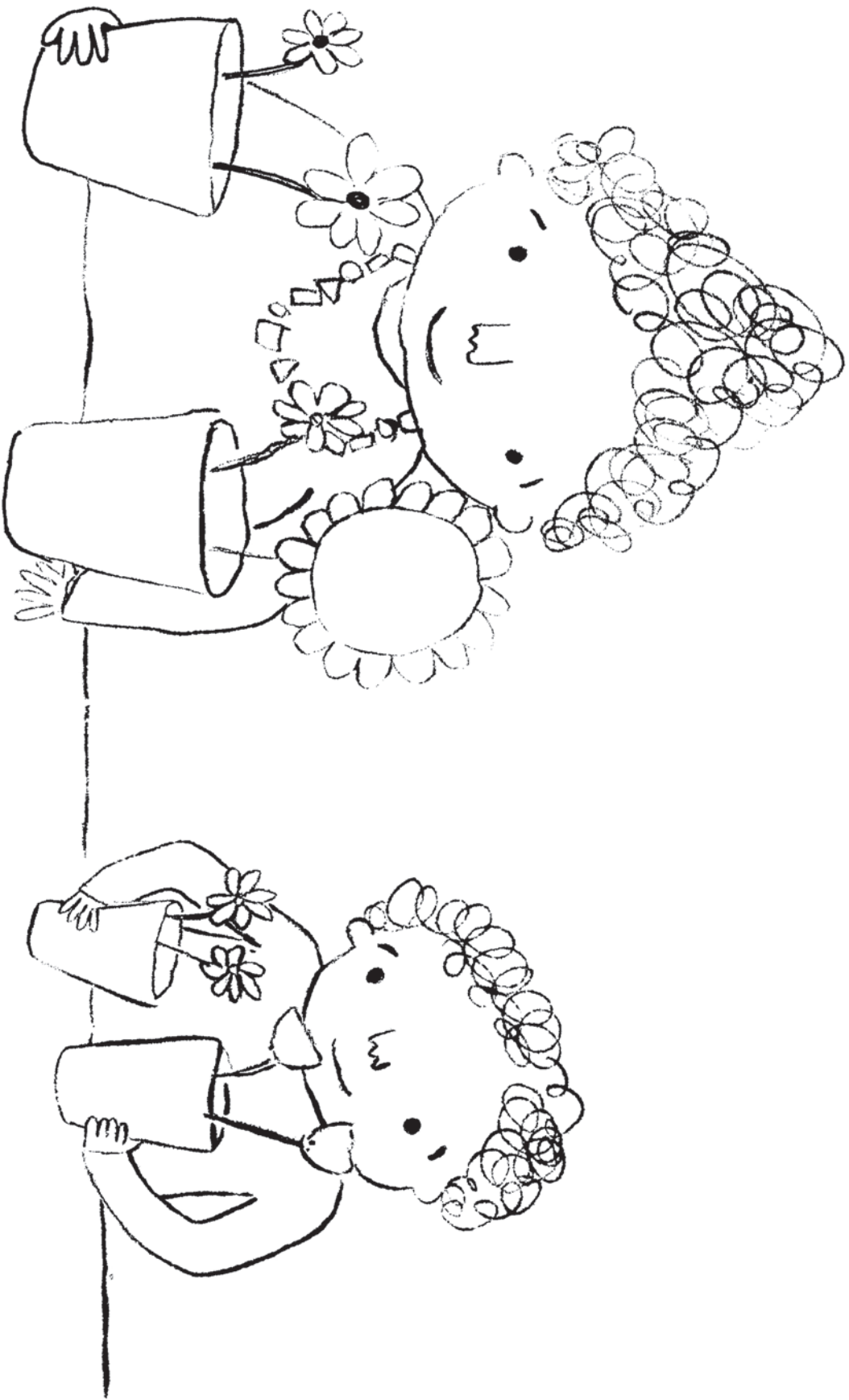
Can you write your name on your very own memory box, decorate it and write or draw the things around it that you would like to remember forever?

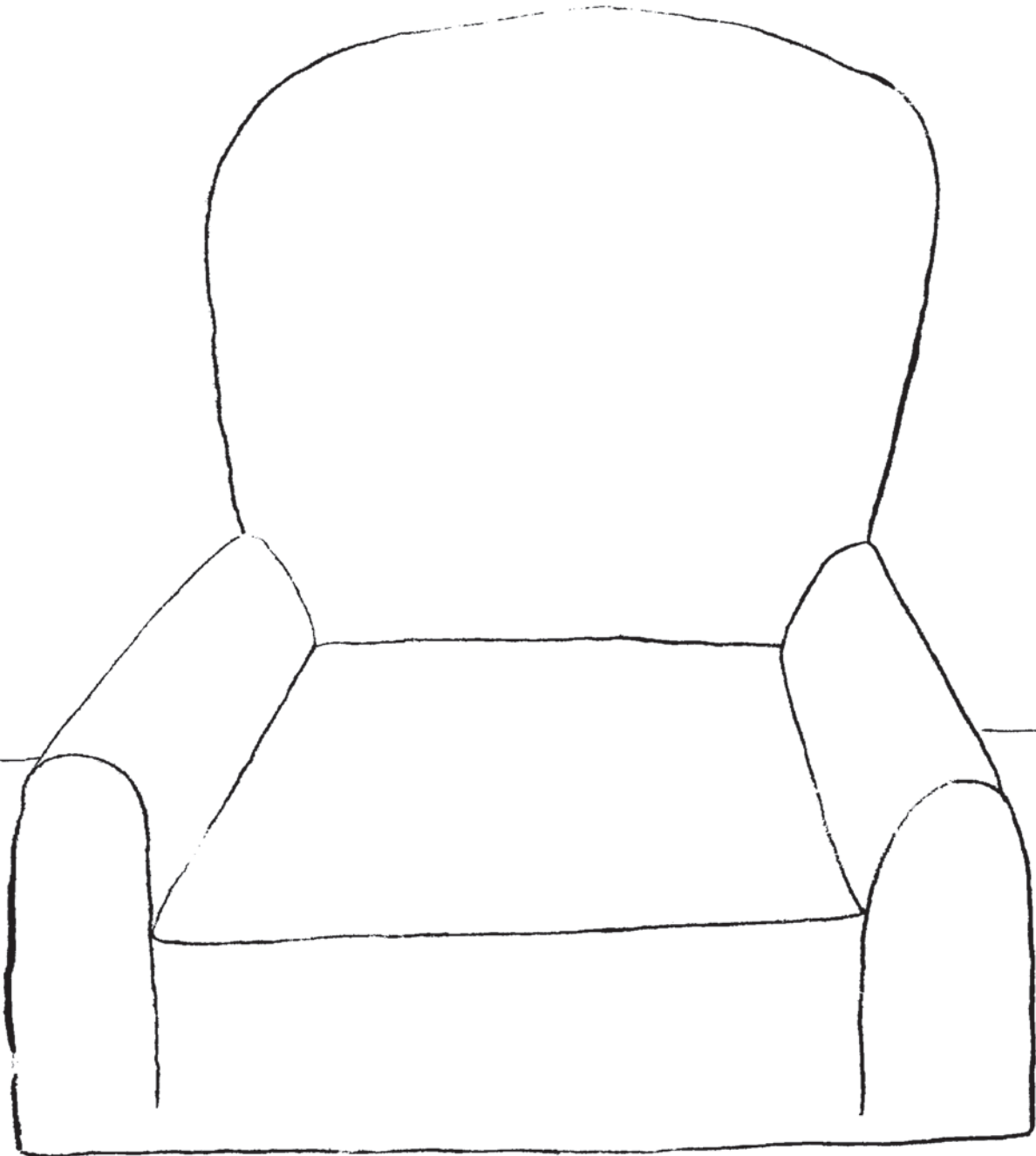


Why is Oscar feeling sad?
